

To protect your family and funeral staff

Full Vaccination is required to attend funerals

Bereavement Authority of Ontario licensed operators can choose the **option** to be exempt from these two **COVID-19** requirements:

1. Physical distancing of two metres between people
2. Capacity limits (number of people)

The establishment can do this only if these conditions are met:

- **All patrons (visitors) must provide proof of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and identification prior to entering**
- **Signs must be posted at all entrances to the premises, and be clearly visible to patrons, informing them proof of vaccination is required in order to enter**

Still required are:

- Wearing a mask or face covering
- Logging of attendees for contact tracing and passive screening (COVID signage at the entrance for guests to self-assess)

(This poster demonstrates that this establishment has chosen the **option** to require that patrons be fully vaccinated. If not participating in this option, capacity limits, physical distancing and all COVID-19 measures must be followed.)
